Traffic diversions on Anna Salai for flyover construction

To facilitate the construction of the 3.2-kilometre elevated flyover on Anna Salai, traffic police has implemented the following traffic diversions from Aug. 16.

Saidapet to Anna flyover: Vehicles travelling from Saidapet on Anna Salai towards the Anna flyover must take a left turn at the Anna Salai-Eldams Road junction, and proceed via Thyagaraya Road, MaPoSijunction, and take a right turn onto North Boag Road to re-join Anna Salai.

Anna Salai to T. Nagar: Vehicles on Anna Salai heading towards T. Nagar can take a right turn at the Anna Salai-Eldams Road junction onto Thyagaraya Road to reach their destination.

T. Nagar to Anna Salai: Motorists going to towards Anna Salai from T. Nagar must take a left turn at the MaPoSi junction on Thyagaraya Road. proceed via Vijayaraghava Road to reach Anna Salai.

South Boag Road restrictions: Vehicles from South Boag Road will not be permitted to take a right turn at the MaPoSi junction. Instead, they must proceed straight onto North Boag Road, then continue to Vijayaraghava Road to access Anna Salai.

Anna flyover to Vijayaraghava Road: Vehicles coming on Anna flyover towards T. Nagar will not be allowed to take a right turn onto Vijayaraghava Road.

Stalin's convoy causes severe traffic jam on Anna Salai

Traffic on Anna Salai from Spencers Plaza to Saidapet came to a standstill for nearly two hours during peak hours on Aug. 12, causing major delays for motorists as traffic police had blocked vehicles near Anna flyover for Chief Minister M.K. Stalin's convoy.

Police said that unlike the usual practice where his vehicle moves with other traffic, this time all vehicles were stopped nearly 10 minutes ahead of the convoy's arrival around 10.20 a.m. Stalin was heading to Tondiarpet to inaugurate the Thayumanavar scheme, via Cathedral Road.

The stoppage brought vehicles near Anna flyover to a standstill, leading to a spilloverjam across the arterial stretch. Police said that only a handful of traffic cops were on the ground as senior officers were away at a meeting.

The chaos continued well into the afternoon, with traffic between Arivalayam and Cenotaph Road crawling for over 30 minutes. Despite heavy congestion, vehicles from by-lanes and Eldams Road continued merging onto Anna Salai unchecked.

"Some motorists were waiting to take a U-turn near Anbagam towards Pandy Bazaar or Gemini. Had police removed the barricades at Eldams Road-Anna Salai junction and manually directed vehicles, it would have helped," K. Arumugam, a motorist said.

"At least the presence of more traffic police could have eased the congestion," D. Prasad of T. Nagar said.



Sri M. Srinivasan

Sri M. Srinivasan was a Senior Advocate, who was later appointed as High Court Judge and still later elevated as Judge of the Supreme Court.

I knew him very well from my early days and had even played cricket with him. He was a good batsman and a medium pace bowler.

When he was on the threshold of being appointed as Judge of Madras High Court, one night I got a call from him at around 8 pm, "Do you know anybody in T. Nagar Police Station?"

I asked him what the matter was. He said, "I got a call from the station asking me to come there for an enquiry". I said immediately, "Sir! You are not going there. I'll go and find out what the matter is and report to you. Even if it should be late, please wait".

I called my friend, Sri M.K. Srinivasan, popularly known as பறக்கும் படை Srinivasan. He was very popular with the public and the police. He was a licensed civil engineer and used to draw sketches for the prosecution in criminal cases. (In Rajiv Gandhi assassination case, it was he who prepared the sketch of the place where the assassination had taken place, and the sketch was later used by the prosecution.)

Knowing his closeness to the police, I sought his help and went with him to the police station at around 8.45 pm.

The Inspector was surprised by the visit of MKS. He said, "Sir, I am under pressure from the Deputy Commissioner. The complainant

is here. According to him, Srinivasan cheated him by not filing any case after receiving Rs. 3,000 as advance fee from him".

I said that it was impossible since Sri MS was an upright person and a fine gentleman. The Inspector said, "Impossible or possible, we are not concerned. We are here to conduct the investigation on the complaint. He must come here tomorrow morning" On our request he gave us a copy of the complaint.

MKS and I rushed to Sri MS's house in nearby Ramaswamy Street at around 10 p.m. He was waiting for us. When the complaint copy was shown to him, he smiled. He took us into his office and took out an index book, from which he got the complainant's file details. The case number was written there. And there were proper accounts. "Received Rs. 3,000. Expenses: Court fee, Bata etc: Rs. 2,725. Clerical, postal, carbon copy etc: Rs. 75". In addition, a post card written by the complainant was pinned to the page. The letter ran like this:

'வக்கீல் ஜியா உங்கள் கடிதம் கிடைத்தது. அப்பீல் விசாரணைக்கு எடுத்துக் கொள்ளப்பட்ட செய்தி கேட்டு மிகக் கூடியச்சி. இந்த ஊர் வக்கீல் ஹெகோர்ட்டிலே இந்த அப்பீலை விசாரணைக்கு எடுத்துக் கொள்ள மாட்டாங்கள்னு சொன்னாரு. நீங்கள் தடையே வாங்கிட்டங்க. ரொம்ப நன்றி'.

I saw the file, the post card and the accounts. I was impressed at the meticulous way in which Sri MS had maintained the accounts.

Next day morning, MKS and I again went to the Police Station. The Inspector was a bit put off since he did not find Sri MS with us. I explained to him how the complaint was a false one, showed him the accounts and also the post card written by the complainant. The Inspector appreciated the facts, slapped the complainant, saying 'நல்ல வேளை நான் தப்பிச்சேன்'.

Back in his home, Sri MS paid the balance amount, though very small, to the complainant and returned the case papers to him after taking a proper receipt.

Obviously the false complaint was the result of a conspiracy against Sri M. Srinivasan getting appointed as a High Court Judge.

I am narrating this incident in order to persuade careless professionals (like me) to maintain proper accounts of their clients' payments. It was amazing that Sri MS had not only maintained accurate accounts but could also retrieve them within minutes.

In my office, I often misplace case bundles and spend a lot of time searching for them. Prayer to Lord Vinayaka for helping me to retrieve a missing letter or a document is quite common. Lord Vinayaka has always come to my rescue! Quite a few coconuts would be broken by me by way of gratitude!

Touched my Heart

Normally, in the Supreme Court, between 1.00 and 1.15 pm daily, Advocates are allowed to mention urgent matters.

One young Advocate from Mumbai was appearing in a Special Leave Petition and sought an early date for its hearing.

Chief Justice: What is the nature of the case?

Counsel: Pension due to a teacher, My Lord

Chief Justice: No! No! No urgency, not possible, after all it is only a matter of pension

Counsel: In fact had told my client, My Lord, that the Supreme Court will not find time to entertain our request. I told him that the Court would find time to hear a case relating to Kapil Dev's non-inclusion in the team even on a Saturday by forming a special Bench. My client is after all a poor teacher, My Lord. Let him suffer.

This bold submission, punctuated with apt words, pricked the Chief Justice. He kept quiet for a two minutes, and then said:

Chief Justice: Court Master, list the case on Monday.

This incident touched me. How many Advocates would have such courage to express what they wanted in such a manner. That too in the Supreme Court?

I met the Advocate outside the court and congratulated him very sincerely.

Events lined up for Madras Day this month

The city will celebrate Madras Day on August 22 with over 75 events throughout the month, ranging from walks and talks to exhibitions and contests. The 2025 edition, which began on August 1, will run until the month end. Over 15 themed walks are planned this year, covering heritage, nature and institutions.

The Madras Naturalists' Society is hosting four nature walks, including trails along Thiruvanmiyur beach.

Nizhal is organising free tree walks at locations such as the DPI campus in Nungambakkam, Natesan Park in T. Nagar and the Kotturpuram Urban Forest. Other heritage walks include two tours inside Fort St. George, a walk around the University of Madras, and guided tours inside IIT Madras led by faculty and students, covering landmarks such as Gajendra Circle. The program also features around 20 talks in English and Tamil. Exhibitions include a display on Tamil print culture and magazines at Roja Muthiah Research Library till Friday, August 22, and a postcard-themed show by the Madras Postcrossing Commune on Sunday, August 17 at Ranade Library (Luz). The British Council is hosting panel discussions on August 22 and 29, with the first exploring 'Food as a living archive of the city's diverse cultures and histories.'



Residents suffer from water contamination for over 6 months

The menace of foul-smelling and discoloured drinking water has worsened on Balakrishna Mudali Street in West Mambalam during the past six months.

Sewage is now visibly leaking and mixing with the water supply.

Despite repeated complaints, Metrowater is yet to identify the source of contamination, residents said.

After multiple complaints, Metrowater identified illegal sewage discharge from stormwater drains connected to nearby buildings.

"When the sump was drained, we saw sewage in the water. We have been spending a hefty amount just to clean the sump, and yet no permanent solution has been provided. Although they checked for possible leaks, the root-cause remains unresolved," a resident of the street said.

Residents now rely on borewell water for domestic purposes and purchase canned water for drinking.

Another resident said that recently when Metrowater workers inspected the area, they found that a sewage pipeline was damaged. It was replaced, and the leakage was arrested. But, even after waiting for the water supply to resume, contaminated water continued to flow.

Residents urge the authorities to identify the root-cause of the issue and address it early.

Last week, the residents of the street met with ward 134 councilor Uma Anandan, who assured them that the issue will be resolved as early as possible.

Appeal to expedite sewer chamber work on Ponnambalam Salai

As an underground sewer chamber on Ponnambalam Salai (K.K. Nagar) was not laid properly, there has been frequent cave in of the road on the stretch for the past six months.

This often poses a problem for the residents of the road and motorists as the stretch gets barricaded to undertake repairs.

K.S. Rajendran (President, Federation of KK Nagar Residents' Welfare Association) said that the quick fixes to the problem were temporary as the problem resurfaced frequently, causing overflow of sewage water from the chamber.

After repeated complaints by the Association, Metrowater undertook a major remedial exercise last month.

This has caused a major section of the road to be cordoned off with only space for 2-wheelers to cross.

With five schools in the vicinity, this blockade has caused a ripple effect as the adjoining roads like Ramaswamy Salai and 66th Street are now choked during school opening and closing hours. The Association appeals to Metrowater to expedite the work.



Viaduct and double-decker corridor works nearing completion

Chennai Metro will complete the construction of the viaduct and the massive double decker stretch along Arcot Road for the phase II project between Porur and Power House by September-end.

Porur to Power House, a section of corridor 4 of the phase II project whose entire length runs to 26.1 km from Light House to Poonamallee via Porur and T. Nagar.

This section is pivotal for commuters for two reasons; firstly, when ready, it offers connectivity to the phase I network at Vadapalani and secondly, the 3.75 km double decker corridor between Alwarthirunagar and Alapakkam will allow commuters to switch between corridor 4 and corridor 5 (Madhavaram to Sholinganallur) in any of the four locations which are Alwarthirunagar, Valasaravakkam, Karambakkam, and Alapakkam. This time next year, trains will be operated in the first level of the double decker and shortly thereafter when a part of corridor 5 is ready, the second level will witness train operations.

According to Chennai Metro officials, they have to construct around 340 piers between Porur and Power House and of that, nearly 95 per cent of the work has been completed in spite of a six-month delay in the construction of the Porur-Power House stretch.

"As the road width was not sufficient on several stretches, it was tough to build the viaduct as cranes could not be stationed to deploy the girders. We had to use a specialized machine to build the piers and stations without disturbing the traffic and launching the girders, leading to delays. Additionally, we also had to safeguard and shift the exiting Metrowater and EB cables before constructing the piers", the official said.

In another 2 months, the entire viaduct will be ready.

Already track laying has begun where the viaduct work has been completed.

Apollo Hospital commissions cath lab for emergency care

Apollo Speciality Hospital (Teynampet) has commissioned an Advanced Catheterisation Laboratory (cath lab) designed to enhance emergency care and minimally invasive interventions in cardiology, neurology, and oncology.

The new system enables complex image-guided procedures without the need for open surgery, allowing faster diagnosis, reduced radiation exposure, and shorter recovery times.

A.L. Narayanan (Head of Interventional Cardiology) said that the Cath Lab integrates high-resolution 3D imaging, stent motion visualisation, neurovascular support systems, and low-dose radiation technology.

He said that it will assist clinicians in treating conditions such as acute heart attacks, strokes, complex vascular blockages, and certain cancers through small incisions or catheter insertions.

Construction worker falls to death while asleep

A 23-year-old migrant worker died after falling from a 3-storey building under construction in Kodambakkam at night on Aug. 11.

According to police, the victim, identified as B. Sakthimaan (native of Uttar Pradesh), was working as a painter with his brother Anil at the construction site in Corporation Colony Kodambakkam.

At night on Aug. 11, following dinner, he and his brother slept at the usual spot next to the water tank on the open terrace of the building. Sakthimaan, who was sleeping close to the edge, rolled over and fell off the building. He hit the compound wall and died on the spot. As it was late in the night, his body was noticed by a worker at the site at around 6.30 a.m.

The Kodambakkam police sent the body to Government K.K. Nagar Hospital for post-mortem. A case has been filed, and an investigation is underway.

Postal staff held for misappropriating Rs 25.48 lakhs

Pondy Bazaar Police on Aug. 10 arrested a 38-year-old staff of the Postal Department on the charge of misappropriating Rs 25.48 lakhs from the T. Nagar Head Post Office, which he allegedly invested in cryptocurrency.

Police said that the complaint was filed at the Pondy Bazaar police station on Aug. 11 after a recent internal audit revealed the financial irregularities. According to the complaint, the funds were allegedly siphoned off using forged documents related to the purchase of stationery and furniture for sub-post offices under the jurisdiction of the head post office. Officials said that Rs. 25 lakhs was shown as the expenditure in 2024-25 for the procurement of stationery and furniture for 50 sub-post offices managed by the head post office.

But the audit revealed that the purchases were never made and documents were forged. After registering a case based on a complaint from a senior official with the Postal Department, the Pondy Bazaar police arrested Manikandan, a Treasury Department staff.

Police investigations revealed that he had misappropriated Rs. 28 lakhs but returned Rs. 3 lakhs and used the remaining money to invest in cryptocurrency and business enterprises. Manikandan was arrested on Aug. 10.

He was produced before a magistrate and remanded to judicial custody.

EB equipment protected by fence



Tamilnadu Electricity Board (TNEB) is erecting a 10-foot-high fence around the EB equipment including an overhead transformer, RMU Unit and two junction boxes installed on the road in KV Colony (West Mambalam). A TNEB official told Anna Nagar Times that the high fence is being erected not only for public safety, but also to prevent encroachments, dumping of waste and to prevent pasting of posters on the junction boxes. He said that similar fences will be erected in other locations in T. Nagar and West Mambalam.


