Chennai Metro

Chennai Metro has completed the safety certification trials of the metro train coaches of phase 2 from Poonamallee bypass to Porur junction.

The safety certification trials were conducted by a team of officials from an external independent agency.

In the safety trials, which commenced on August 16, the certification team evaluated passenger ride comfort at varying speeds up to the design speed of 90 km/h.

The testing also included detailed assessment of the traction system performance and extensive testing of braking performance under different modes. It also evaluated ride quality, where assessment was made to determine the quality of rolling stock along with the track to ascertain the level of comfort for a travelling passenger.

Additionally, assessment was also conducted to determine the train's safety features including electrical, pneumatic and emergency braking features.

SRM hosts faculty convocation

SRM Institute of Science and Technology (SRM IST) (Vadapalani) hosted the convocation for faculty members who have completed a comprehensive three-day faculty development program conducted by the School of Design Thinking (SoDT). SoDT's vision aligns with SRM IST's purpose of nurturing a new generation of leaders who are empathetic, creative, and solution-focused. The School of Design Thinking has conducted the Faculty Development Program for 14 batches of faculty members across its Kattankulathur, Tiruchy, NCR and Vadapalani campuses. This year, 110 faculty members from all major engineering departments received their certificates. They join a cohort of 165 faculty alumni from the first convocation event, making a total of 275 SRMIST faculty trained in Design Thinking since the inception of the program in 2019.

Smart water ATMs to be installed in Corporation Schools

Chennai Corporation will soon install smart water ATMs in 16 of its schools. They include five schools in the Kodabakkam Zone, 4 in Adyar Zone, 3 in Thiru Vi Ka Nagar Zone, 2 in Royapuram Zone, and 1 each in Sholinganallur and Anna Nagar Zone.

An official said that the schools where more than 1,000 students are enrolled were selected. The schools selected in Kodambakkam Zone are Corporation Higher Secondary School (MGR Nagar, K.K. Nagar), Corporation Schools located in West Saidapet, Kodambakkam Salai and Jones Road in Saidapet, and Chennai Middle School (MGR Nagar, T. Nagar).

Lecture given on history of AVM Museum

In connection with Madras Day, Mohan V. Raman (actor and historian) gave a lecture on the history of AVM Heritage Museum ((38, Ave Meiyappan Road, Ottagapalayam, Kannika Puram, Vadapalani) on Aug. 23.

Historian V. Sriram and film producer M.S. Guhan also spoke on the occasion.

The lectures were organised by Madras Musings.

The Museum houses an impressive collection of more than 40 cars and 20 motorcycles that have appeared in Tamil movies from the 1960s to now.

Visitors can see iconic vehicles such as the Suzuki RV 90, ridden by Superstar Rajinikanth in the movie Paayum Puli, and the Buick Super 8 driven by Kamal Haasan in Sakalakala Vallavan.

Apart from cars, visitors can also learn about the bulky audio and video equipment used in pre-digital cinema, film promotion techniques from the past, and the costumes worn by actors.

The cameras used for Murattu Kaalai and Mundhanai Mudichu, analogue multitrack and single-track recorders, mikes of different kinds used for playback singing and dubbing, conventional video editing setup, and the giant fan used to create artificial heavy winds all tell tales of how movie-making has evolved in the last few decades.

Some vintage cars on display include a Dodge Kingsway owned by MGR, Vauxhall Velox owned by S. S. Vasan and Vauxhall 14 owned by A. V. Meiyappan.

The museum is open to the public from Wednesday to Monday from 10 a.m to 5 p.m. It is closed on Tuesdays and national holidays.

The entry fee is Rs. 200 per adult and Rs. 150 per child.

Thousands visit village festival held at YMCA

The annual urban village festival 'Sempozhil - Chennaiyil Oru Gramathu Thiruvizha' held at YMCA (Nandanam) from Aug., 21 to 24, attracted thousands of visitors.

The festival was joint effort of actor Karthi's Uzhavan Foundation (NGO that works for the welfare of marginalized farmers) and Thondaimandalam Foundation (NGO that works towards enhancing and sustaining rural and peri-urban livelihoods). Actor Karthi visited the event on Aug. 24 and presented a motivational talk.

The event featured more than 100 stalls that showcases fresh harvest ranging from vegetables, and rice varieties to country milk, food stalls selling millet ice creams, paruthi paal (cottonseed milk), beetroot cola, and more.

Elevated corridor costliest at Rs. 195 crores per km



The 3.2 km Teynampet-Saidapet elevated corridor under construction by the Tamilnadu Highways Department is touted as the country's first elevated corridor built above a metro tunnel. The four-lane flyover, for which work began in 2024, has the highest construction cost of Rs 195. crores per km, bringing the total project cost to Rs 621 crores.

In contrast, the National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) has estimated the cost of its ongoing six-lane elevated projects at Rs. 120-Rs 130 crores per km over the same period, making the Teynampet elevated corridor project costlier by around 50%.

As per official documents, the Teynampet project's estimated cost, fixed at Rs 482 crores in April 2022, was raised to Rs 525 crores in March 2023 before rising by 18% (Rs. 96 crores) to reach Rs 621 crore within a year.

The new 4-lane corridor aims to reduce the travel time between Teynampet and Saidapet on Anna Salai from 40 minutes to just 10 minutes, while easing congestion at seven key intersections — Eldams Road, SIET College Road, Cenotaph Road, Nandanam, CIT Nagar, CIT Nagar 1st Main Road (towards T Nagar), and Jones Road.

A senior highways official attributed the high cost to factors like soil stabilisation, extensive utility relocations in a densely-congested area, and advanced construction techniques to minimise pillar loads and safeguard the underground metro tunnel.

The Chennai Metro tracks run 17-18 metres beneath Anna Salai.

Since drilling for laying the flyover foundation could only be done up to 7 metres, additional strengthening techniques are being deployed to strengthen the foundation.

The elevated road spans 2.4 km directly above the metro line, and 655 metres along the non-metro stretch (excluding entry and exit ramps).

In total, 69 pillars are being erected above the metro line, 22 on the non-metro stretch, and 41 portal frames covering the 460 metres over the two stations. As of July, about 30% of the work had been completed.


Stone pillar engraved with football rules installed in YMCA

A 3-metre-tall stone pillar weighing 770 kgs, unveiled last week at YMCA College of Physical Education (Teynampet), has engravings in Tamil of the original 1848 Cambridge Rules of football. It was commissioned by Cambridge City Council (United Kingdom) in association with Street Child United (NGO based in UK). In all, nine stone pillars in different languages including Tamil were engraved, and five of them have been installed in various countries, including at YMCA in Chennai.

Etched on it are the 11 Cambridge Rules of Football - regarded as the earliest written code of the game. The pillar was initially gifted to Karunalaya (Tondiarpet), Street Child's partner in India.

As the Karunalaya's founders felt the monument deserved a more public sporting stage, YMCA College was chosen as the ideal location to install it.



MTC launches special buses for school students



Metropolitan Transport Corporation (MTC) on Aug. 18 launched 25 buses exclusively for the travel of school students. Students will be allowed to travel free of cost on these special services. The buses will leave their respective depots between 6.50 a.m and 8.05 am, stopping at designated points before reaching schools.

In the afternoon, return trips will operate between 1.50 p.m and 4.10 p.m. Each bus will make 50 trips daily between schools and terminals, halting at fixed stops.

In the next phase, MTC will launch special buses for college students. The 25 bus routes include route 11M from Iyyappan-thangal to Government Girls Higher Secondary School (Ashok Nagar).

New building with 110 beds to be opened in Saidapet GH

A new building to house 110 beds will soon be inaugurated in Saidapet Government Hospital, which is over 100 years old. Health Minister Ma. Subramanian said that the stilt + 6-storey complex spanning 68,290 sq.ft was constructed at a cost of Rs. 28.70 crores.

The ground floor section comprises access areas and parking zone, the 1st floor will house outpatient and immunisation units, pharmacy and scan rooms. The 2nd floor will have labour wards, pre and post-natal wards, emergency wards and nursing stations. On the 3rd floor, an integrated laboratory is being set up at a cost of Rs. 1 crore along with ENT and Paediatric sections. The 4th floor will accommodate a 15-bed paediatrics ward, 14-bed general medicine ward and 12-bed post-natal ward. The 5th floor will have the general medicine ward with 43 beds, while the sixth floor will have three fully equipped operation theatres and pre-operative wards. Fourteen dialysis machines sponsored by Rotary Clubs are functioning at the hospital, and the Club is likely to sponsor 11 more machines.

When the building is inaugurated, a total of 25 dialysis machines will be operational, offering free dialysis to patients. In addition, Rotary Club has also come forward to set up a blood bank at a cost of Rs. one crore.

Students take up odd jobs to earn a living

G. Gnanavelu (a BA Literature student and resident of Ashok Nagar) borrows his brother's motorcycle on weekends to earn money by acting as a bike taxi driver. This money takes care of my side expenses and I don't have to depend on my parents or brother for pocket money, he said.

He said that many college students, including girl students, engage in part-time jobs to earn some money. Many students work after college hours in restaurants, beauty parlours and other such places as it helps them earn money in their spare time and also prepare them for the rigour of a professional career, post education, he said.

Consumer Cell helps in claiming bounced cheque amount

The Chennai North District Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission directed an international private bank to pay Rs. 17 lakhs as compensation to a customer after a courier company lost a bounced cheque in transit.

According to the complainant L. Dinesh (resident of T. Nagar), a cheque for Rs. 17 lakhs received from a third party and deposited in his account with Standard Chartered Bank, bounced due to insufficient funds.

Following this, the bank sent the cheque to his address through DTDC Express, but he never received it though the bank said it was delivered in February 2024.

When the staff at the DTDC branch admitted that the cheque was lost and was untraceable, Dinesh initiated the complaint with the bank.

Later, when DTDC officials backtracked and said that they had proof of delivery, it was found that the signature on the acknowledgement slip was forged.

Dinesh faced a huge financial crisis but could not file a legal case against the drawer due to the missing cheque.

After reviewing the complaint, the Commission held that the bank alone is liable for failure to return the dishonoured cheque to Dinesh and deficiency in banking service, and directed the bank to pay the dishonoured cheque amount of Rs 17 lakhs as compensation towards deficiency in service and Rs. 5,000 towards litigation cost.

Strict vending rules to curb hawking

To rein in around one lakh street vendors, the majority of whom are illegal, Chennai Corporation has unveiled a new policy which bans vendors from arterial roads, prohibits them from vending near schools, colleges, and hospitals, and restricts them on narrow roads.



The new policy, approved by the Corporation Town Vending Committee and notified in the Tamilnadu government gazette in July, came into force in August.

The new rules mandate that the stalls must be limited to 6x4 metres and carry bilingual signage. No vending will be allowed within 100 meters of schools or hospitals and 150 meters of major administrative and transit hubs.

Twentytwo arterial roads, including Valluvarkottam High Road and Arcot Road are out of bounds for vendors. No vending will be allowed on streets that are up to 1-meter-wide, and only on one side, on other roads.

Officials said that the new norms will be strictly enforced across the city, especially in commercial hubs in T. Nagar. To enforce the new rules, Corporation has formed division-wise enforcement teams headed by executive engineers and procured two vehicles per zone for four officials for patrolling.

Last week, the Corporation removed around 78 roadside shops from 2nd Avenue (Anna Nagar).

Resident Welfare Associations have raised objections as Corporation has made entire stretches of many roads, including Arya Gowda Road (West Mambalam), as vending zones.

K. Sreedharan of T. Nagar-West Mambalam Welfare Forum said that there are only a couple of flower and fruit vendors on Arya Gowda Road now.

"As the entire stretch is now permitted as vending zone, eateries and tea stalls will start to proliferate on the congested two-lane road. No public opinions were sought in this matter," he said.

Prime accused in murder case nabbed after 11 years

The police on Aug. 25 arrested the prime accused in the case pertaining to the murder of a security guard in 2014.

The accused, Biswajit (39) of Assam, was traced and arrested from Kolapakkam.

On August 11, 2014, Poonganni (resident of West Mambalam) had lodged a complaint alleging foul play in the death of his son Manickam, a security guard at an apartment complex in K.K. Nagar.

Manickam, who was initially admitted to Royapettah Government Hospital after he fell ill, was found to have multiple injuries. The postmortem confirmed that he had been beaten to death.

The case was altered to murder, and two men, Obed of Nagaland and Kantharupan of Ramanathapuram were arrested on August 14, 2014.

But Biswajit, had been absconding since then.

TNEB starts fixing exposed underground cables



After a couple of fatal electrocutions in different parts of the city, Tamilnadu Electricity Board (TNEB) has embarked on a drive to fix hundreds of exposed underground cables to prevent such accidents. 150 contract workers have been deployed to identify and bury the exposed cables under the supervision of senior officials.

An official said that 674 exposed underground cables had already been identified for repair as part of pre-monsoon preparedness work, and 80% of them have been completed.

Areas including K.K. Nagar, Ashok Nagar and T. Nagar are already covered, and most of the cables were buried underground with the cooperation of Chennai Corporation," he said. Though the work began a month back, it was accelerated to prevent further incidents.

While welcoming the initiative, (P. Santhanam, resident of Thambiah Road, West Mambalam) said that any digging activity undertaken by civic bodies must be done after seeking permission from TNEB. He said that while widening the storm water drain on Thambiah Road, several EB cables got exposed and were often covered in water that filled these trenches. Corporation workers worked in these trenches oblivious to the danger of electrocution. After intervention by residents and thanks to a report published in *Mambalam Times*, a separate PVC pipe was fixed adjoining the trench to run the exposed cables to prevent any untoward incident, he said.

Corporation Council clears resolutions on infra work

Chennai Corporation Council on Aug. 26 passed 84 resolutions covering civic infrastructure, canal strengthening, conservancy machinery, school sanitation and market facilities.

A new fish market will be built in Kodambakkam Zone with modern stalls, storage and basic amenities. Temporary workers have been appointed to clean schools in Teynampet and Anna Nagar Zone, especially for sanitation. A new playground for children will be developed on O.P. Salai (Teynampet) at a cost of Rs. 1.56 crores. Flood prevention and canal restoration projects formed a major part of the agenda.

For conservancy operations, the council sanctioned the rental of 23 suction machines for four months at Rs. 1.47 crores, procurement of six hydraulic operated self-propelled tree pruning machines for five years at Rs. 5.23 crores, and one robotic multipurpose excavator with one-year maintenance at Rs. 1.82 crores. A heavy-duty road sweeper machine will also be deployed.
