CM Stalin inaugurates South Usman Road flyover

Chief Minister M.K. Stalin on Sept. 30 inaugurated the 1.2 kms steel flyover over South Usman Road (T. Nagar), constructed at a cost of Rs. 164.92 crores. The flyover has been named after former DMK MLA J. Anbazhagan, who represented the T. Nagar assembly constituency in 2001.

The flyover which connects South Usman Road with CIT Nagar First Main Road, is linked to the North Usman Road flyover at Madley junction, offering direct connectivity to Anna Salai from Panagal Park.



Trees pruned ahead of monsoon

Residents have raised complaints over the delay in the construction of bridges and storm water drains across the city, and have demanded Chennai Corporation to expedite and complete the works before the Northeast monsoon.

A member of T. Nagar Residents' Welfare Association said that the construction of South Usman Road flyover has got delayed by over a year, and he hopes for its completion, as assured by the officials, by the end of this month.

He said that other than completing the flyover work, the authorities must also ensure that the damaged sewer and storm water drain networks in the vicinity of the flyover are restored to prevent sewage overflow / flooding during monsoon.

B. Kannan (President of the Association) said that the work should also be expedited to allow storm water to drain from the area to the canal in CIT Nagar to prevent flooding.

Arappor Iyakkam celebrates 10th anniversary

Arappor Iyakkam, a people's movement started in 2015, celebrated its 10th anniversary recently in Sir Pitty Thyagaraya Hall (T. Nagar).

During the meet, it launched the campaign 'My Vote is Not for Sale', aiming to reach households across all 234 constituencies in Tamilnadu, urging citizens not to accept money for votes.

It showcased its decade-long journey of exposing corruption, restoring water bodies, securing land rights for tribal communities, and conducting RTI awareness programs, through a video at the event.

Carnatic vocalist and writer T.M. Krishna, Sudha Ramalingam (Lawyer and activist), Henri Tiphagne from People's Watch, Kalpana Karunakaran (IIT-M professor), Siddharth Prabhakar (Journalist), and Raju Murugan (Filmmaker) held a panel discussion on the topic 'Arappor's role in social change'.

Thiru Vi Ka Nagar zone topped the list with 4,407 trees trimmed, followed by Teynampet (4,232) and Kodambakkam (4,072).

Each zone deployed 13 workers along with vehicles and equipment, including 342 power saws, 280 telescopic machines, nine hydraulic machines, and two hydraulic lifts.


'வாந்தி இருக்கிறதா?'



Poonamallee-Porur metro stretch set for December launch

Chennai Metro is preparing to open the Poonamallee-Porur stretch by this December with six-coach trains.

The Porur-Kodambakkam and Koyambedu-Nandanam stretches are expected to begin operations by June 2026, while the Madhavaram-Sholinganallur corridor is planned for launch by March 2027.

Phase II of the Chennai Metro project covers 116 km across three corridors, with an estimated cost of Rs 63,246 crores.

The routes include Madhavaram-SIPCOT, Poonamallee-Lighthouse, and Madhavaram-Manapakkam.

Officials said that construction is progressing rapidly, with the entire network scheduled for completion by 2028.

A total of 138 trains, including 32 driverless trains, will be operated under Phase II.

Corporation to fix microchips in pet dogs

Chennai Corporation is all set to launch a revamped portal to register and track pet dogs across the city.

The initiative will be formally inaugurated by Mayor R. Priya, who will also flag off a city-wide microchipping drive of pet dogs.

The project is designed to curb pet abandonment and strengthen accountability among dog owners.

According to Corporation officials, owners will be required to provide vaccination certificates, identification marks, and address details before registering their pets.

Each dog will then be microchipped to maintain vaccination records and aid in tracking.

Corporation Commissioner J. Kumaragurubaran said that the council had earlier approved the project and a contractor had been appointed.

"Now the portal is ready, and the Mayor will launch it soon," he said.

Sterilisation work is being accelerated across nine zones and is expected to be completed by the end of December. Together with microchipping, Corporation aims to improve pet ownership responsibility and strengthen animal management in the city, he said.

Nearby residents appeal to Chennai Corporation to repair the road before monsoon.

15,000 tonnes steel to be used in elevated corridor:



A total of 15,000 tonnes of steel structures will be used in the 3.2-km, 4-lane elevated corridor under construction on Anna Salai (between Saidapet and Teynampet junctions) at a cost of Rs. 621 crores.

Since a section of the flyover will be constructed over the underground metro rail network, extra precautions are being taken to ensure the twin tunnels below are safe.

As piling is not allowed on the stretch, isolated footing, a type of foundation for piers, will be done in the stretch, and prefabricated steel structures will be used for building the flyover to keep the load over the underground tunnels on the stretch to a minimum.

An official said that even the soil around the tunnels will remain undisturbed up to a certain depth. The top layers of soil, where short micro-piles are coming up, are being strengthened with geo-textile. The flyover will span seven key intersections, including Eldams Road, SIET College Road, and Cenotaph Road.

EB equipment protected by fence

Tunnelling on Corridor 3 metro link nearing completion

After being dogged by delays due to various reasons, the metro rail tunnel in Corridor 3 between Greenways Road and Mandaveli is nearing completion.

According to Chennai Metro officials, the project which was a part of the 45.8-kilometer Corridor 3 from Madhavaram to SIPCOT was originally slated to be completed in six months but was prolonged for nearly two years.

The delay was mainly attributed to challenges in relocating major underground utilities at the Mandaveli station site.

Officials said that constructing the station's diaphragm wall required the diversion of four massive water and sewer pipelines.

The project is spearheaded using two tunnel boring machines named 'Noyyal' and 'Vaigai' with the former beginning its 750-meter journey in September 2023 and currently nearing a breakthrough at Mandaveli over the next few weeks. Officials said that following this development, train services on the Greenways Road to Thirumayilai stretch will be launched as per schedule by 2028.

Two held for assaulting sanitary workers

53,000 stray dogs vaccinated

Chennai Corporation has administered rabies vaccination to more than 53,000 stray dogs in the city since the drive was launched by Mayor R. Priya on Aug. 8.

Corporation aims to vaccinate 1 lakh stray dogs by end November.

According to a census by the civic body, there are over 1.8 lakh stray dogs in the city.

In addition to vaccinations, Corporation is also implanting microchips in sterilized dogs to monitor and manage the dog population effectively.

An official said that so far, 12,580 street dogs have been fitted with microchips.

Chennai Corporation has also floated a tender of Rs 7.67 crores to construct shelters for rabies-affected dogs in Madhavaram and Velachery.

Each shelter can accommodate 250 dogs.

Drunk man collapses while arguing with police, dies

Stray cattle problem on Arya Gowda Road



Sir, I am a resident of Postal Colony (West Mambalam) and own a shop on Arya Gowda Road. Stray cattle nuisance continues unabated in and around Arya Gowda Road. The bovines squat in the middle of the road and on pavements, causing obstruction to motorists and pedestrians.

Despite assurances of strict action by Chennai Corporation, and reports in the media that thousands of stray cattle have been impounded and the owners fined, the nuisance continues. It appears that after paying the fine, cattle owners again let them loose on public roads as they probably do not have a shed to shelter them.

Additionally, the Corporation only has two pounds to handle the seized cattle, leading to transportation challenges and lack of space. I wonder how the authorities can find a permanent solution to this without building the necessary infrastructure. **S. Sudarshan, Postal Colony, West Mambalam.**

Congestion at Madley junction despite opening new flyover

Sir, While the opening of the new flyover over Usman Road (T. Nagar) has reduced congestion along the commercial hub of South and North Usman Roads, the congestion at Madley junction continues during peak hours as the exit ramp from North Usman Road side ends almost 400 meters before the junction.

As vehicles including MTC buses have to travel 400 meters on the narrow service lane after exiting the ramp to reach Madley junction, it is causing congestion, especially during peak hours. With big textile and jewellery showrooms lining the 400-meter stretch, it only adds to the problem. If the exit ramp had ended much closer to the junction, the congestion could have been reduced.

At around 6 p.m. on Oct. 2, it took me 15 minutes to reach Madley junction after exiting the ramp. **R. Parthasarathy, Burkit Road, T. Nagar.**

It's a dogfight over feeding strays

The long-running conflict among residents of feeding stray dogs gained momentum after the recent Supreme Court ruling on stray dogs, and a popular Tamil television debate on the issue going viral on the social media.

P. Guakesh (resident of Giri Road, off G.N. Chetty Road, T. Nagar) said that there has been a rapid increase in stray dog population in his area as, in spite of objections by residents of the colony, a man from a local meat shop feeds leftovers to the dogs daily. He said that some of the dogs are ferocious and chase vehicles. Seniors and children are scared to venture out, he said.

Similarly, M. Sudhakar (a resident of Postal Colony, West Mambalam) said that a pack of over 20 dogs roam the streets in his area as some outsiders feed them daily. In the past few months, several children have been bitten, and despite repeated complaints to the Corporation, no action has been taken to relocate the dogs, he said.

In gated communities, tensions are rising. Associations have issued guidelines against feeding strays inside premises, but some animal lovers continue to defy the rules.

A senior veterinarian running a clinic in Ashok Nagar said that feeding alone does not make dogs aggressive.

"What matters is feeding responsibly and placing food in less congested areas to prevent barking and fights. The recent Supreme Court order on stray dogs has also been widely misunderstood. The court did not ban feeding but stressed that it must be done responsibly, at designated locations, with sensitivity to both residents and animal welfare," he said.

V.P. Jeyaseelan (Joint Commissioner, Health) said that Corporation is in the process of identifying suitable locations across the city to be designated as feeding zones for strays, in line with the Supreme Court order.

The list will be released soon," he said.

New flyover eases congestion near Ranganathan Street
